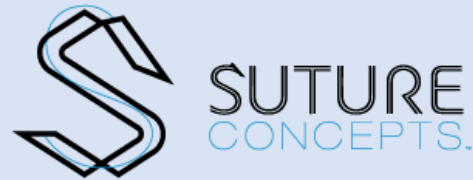

LEAD LOOP™ COMMONLY BILLED HCPCS CODES

The following chart provides commonly billed HCPCS Level II codes for the Suture Concepts Lead Loop™. For most non-Medicare plans, L-Codes or Revenue Codes, as provided below, may be appropriate for reporting purposes. For the Medicare outpatient hospital settings, however, C -Codes are required for billing with applicable CPT codes, but they are not separately payable by Medicare. Suture Concepts strongly recommends you consult with the appropriate payer on proper reporting options for implantable devices and supporting accessories.
